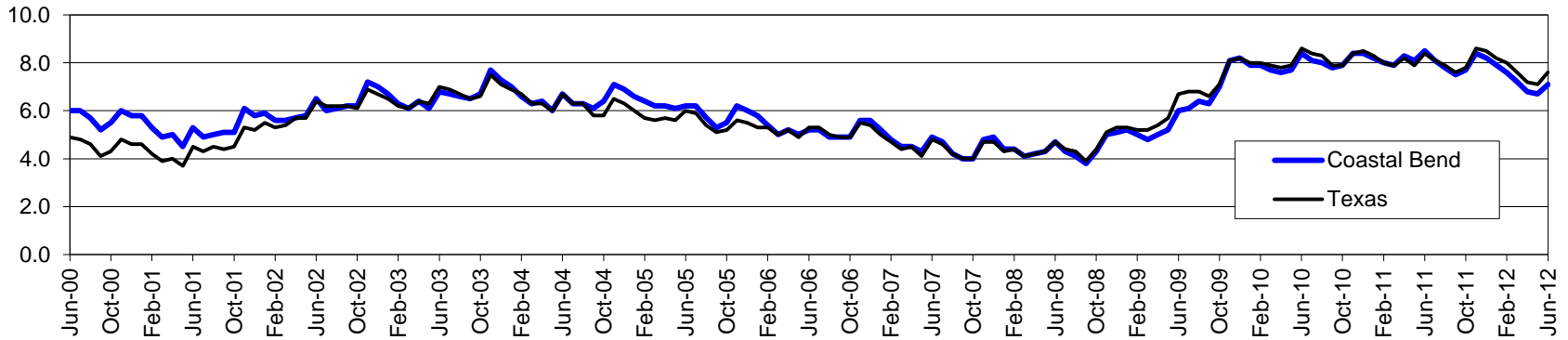

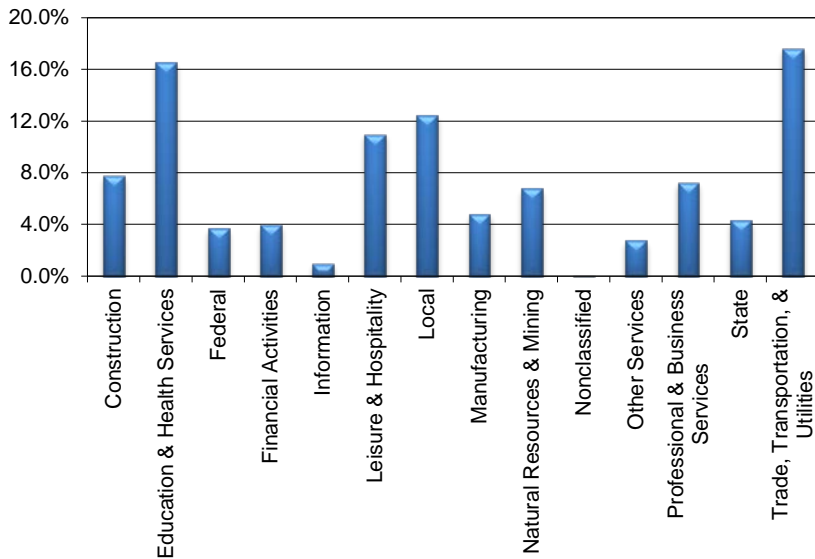

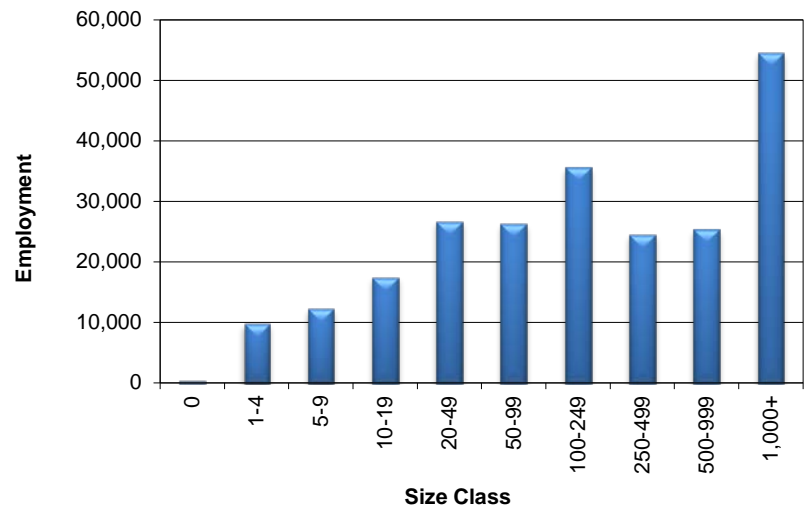

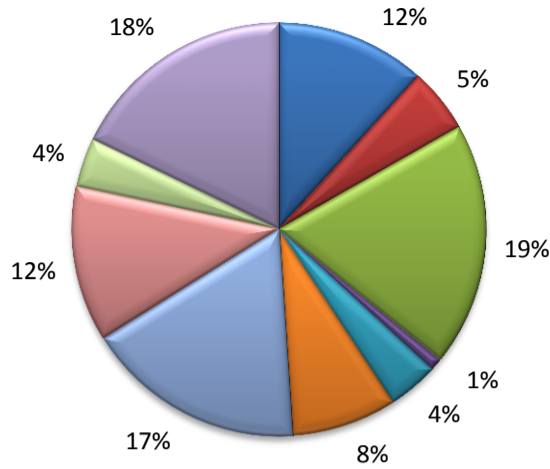
Size Class Employment Composition 4th Quarter 2011

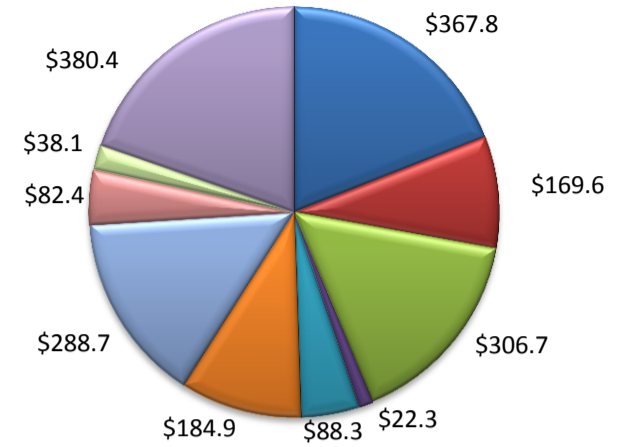

4th Quarter 2011



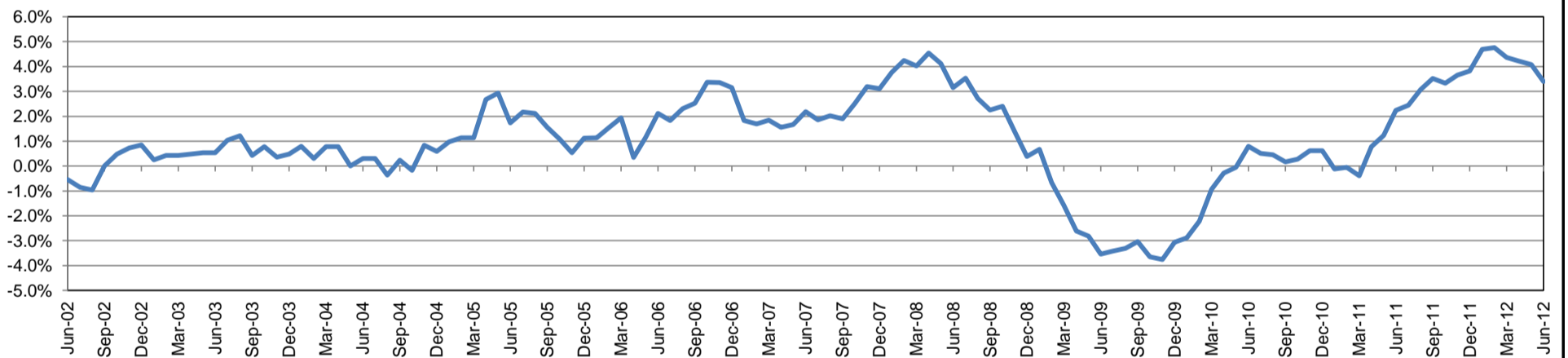
