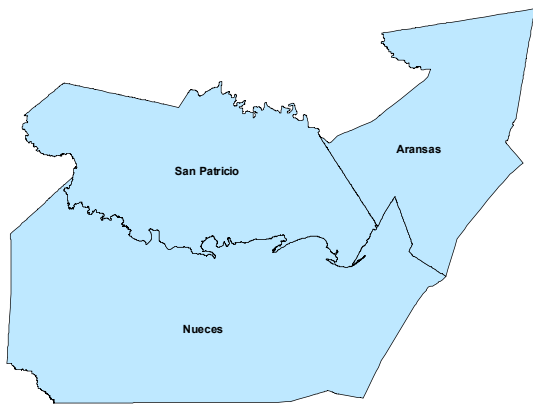

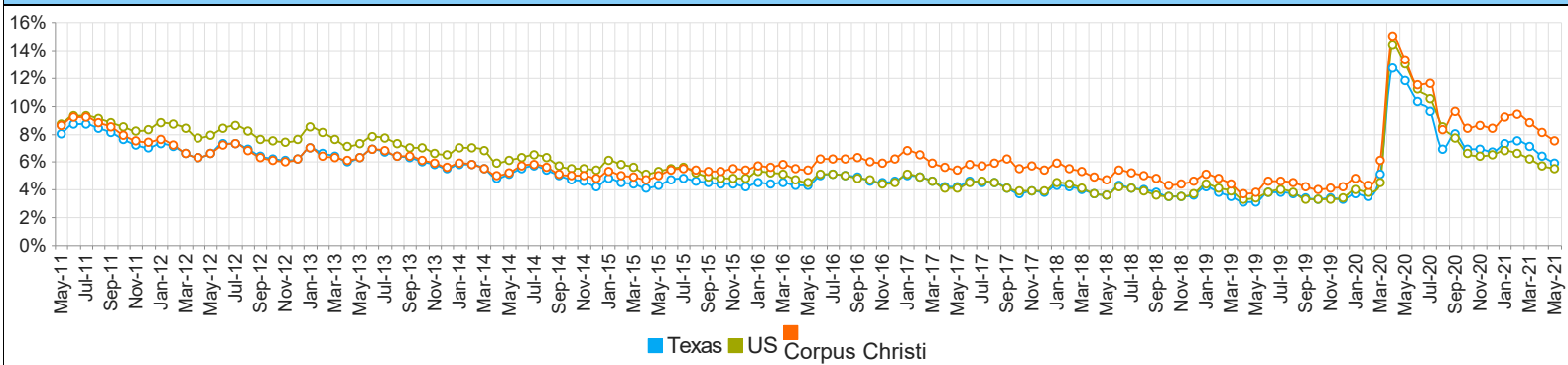

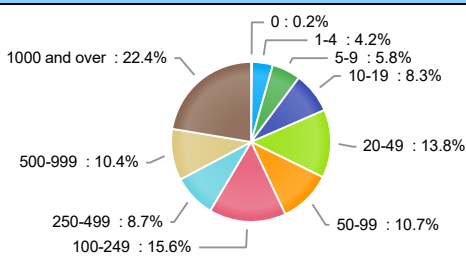

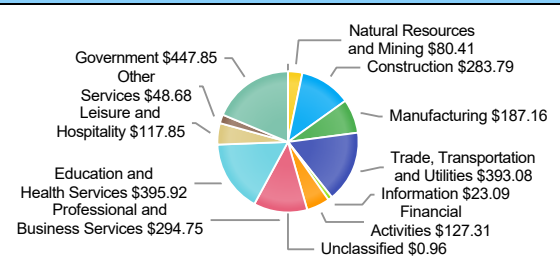
Historical Unemployment Rates



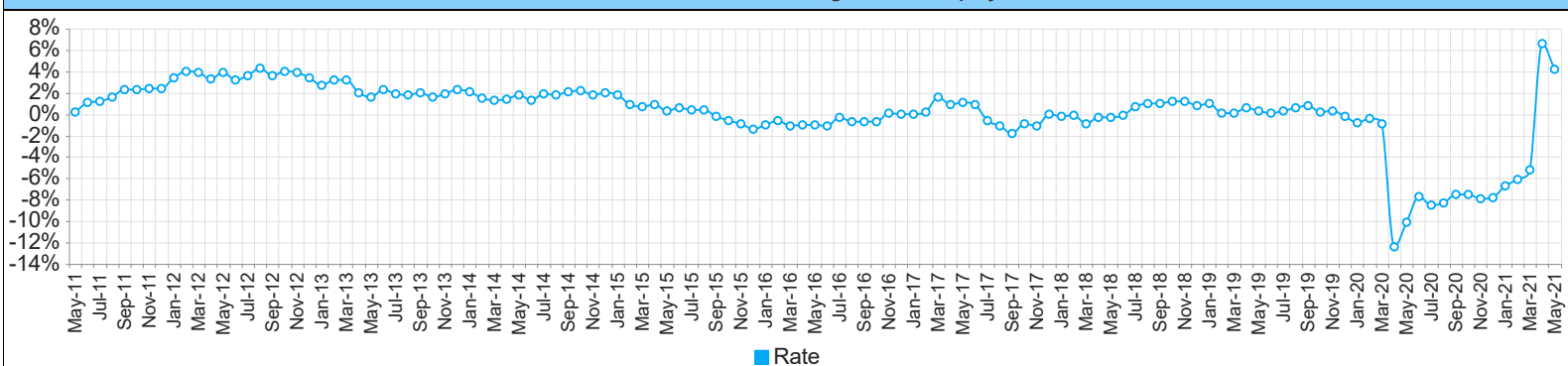
Employment by Size Class (4th Quarter 2020)



Wages by Industry (in millions) (4th Quarter 2020)



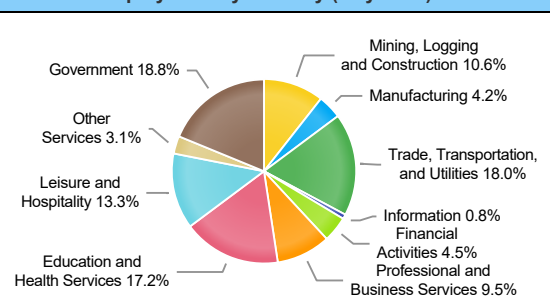
Annual Growth Rate Total Non-agricultural employment

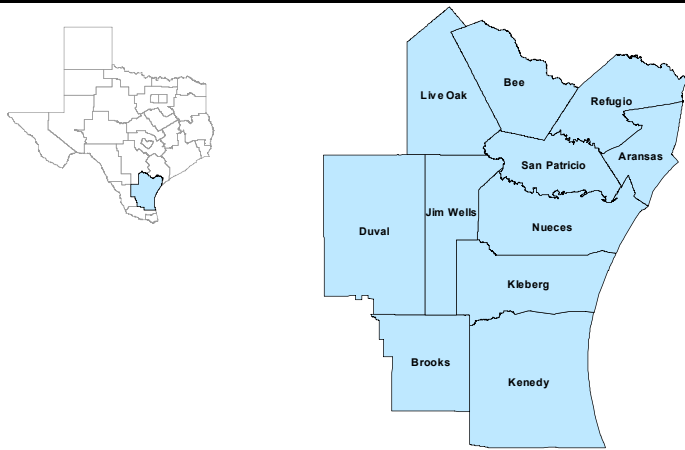

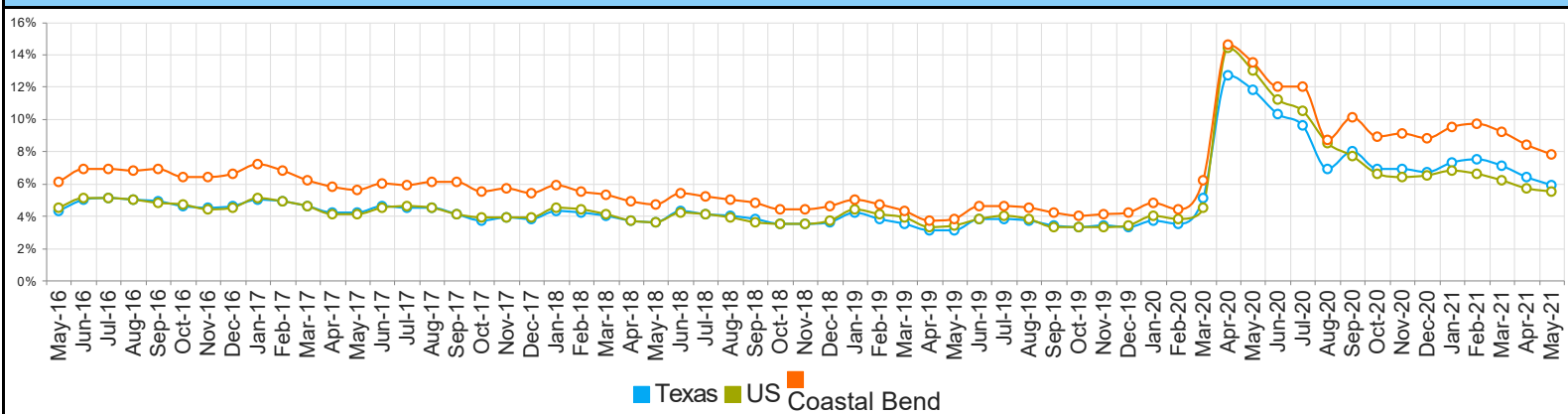

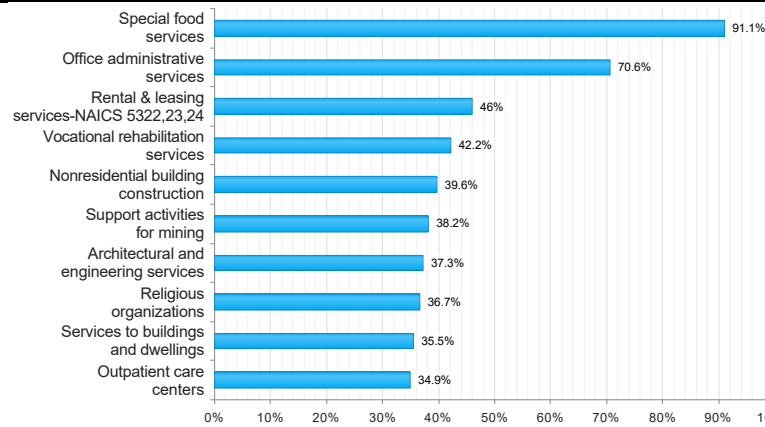

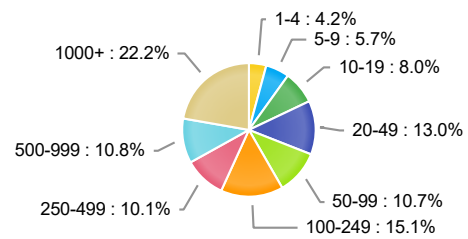
Historical Unemployment Rates



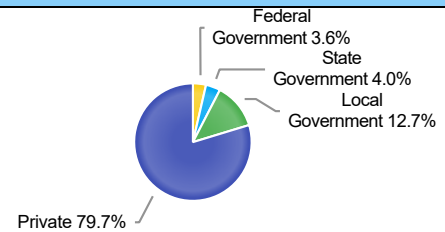
Projected Top Ten Fastest Growing Industries in WDA (% Growth 2018-2028)
